ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

A. UNDERGRADUATES/DGREE PROGRAMMES

The University's requirements for the Degree Programme are five (5) credits GCE O'Level /WASSCE including English Language in not more than two sittings. In the case of the West African Examination Council Exams, only grades varying from 1-6 are recognized as GCE O'Levels credit passes. For WASSCE it is A1 – C6 while for the Associate Examination Board (London GCE) only C or better are recognized.

Applicants should note that there are additional departmental requirements.

Also that some schools start their Honours programmes in the 3rd Year.

Students are admitted into the General programmes and have to Score above 3.60 and above before they can enter the Honours Programme.

B. CERTIFICATE & DIPLOMA PROGRAMMS

Four (4) WASSCE/GCE Credits including English Language will be considered for admission into Higher Diploma Programmes, Higher Diploma in Ophthalmic for Community Health Officers (OCHO) (only CHOs with 5 year working experience can apply) and Three (3) credits for Certificate and Ordinary Diploma including English Language.

Please note that admission into SRN and CHO programmes requires Five (5) Credits GCE O'Level/WASSCE including English Language in not more than two sittings.

Entry Requirements into Diplomas and Certificate programmes in the School of Social Sciences and Law are as follows:

i. **Higher Diploma in Banking and Finance**

An applicant must have passed the West African Senior School Certificate Examinations (WASSCE) with credit or better in at least four (4) subjects in not more than two (2) sittings and, perform reasonably well in the interview will be considered.

ii. **Diploma in Social Work**

An applicant must have passed the West African Senior School Certificate Examinations (WASSCE) with credit or better in at least three (3) subjects in not more than two (2) sittings and, perform reasonably well in the interview will be considered.

iii. **Certificate in Social Work**

An applicant must have passed O'Level or WASSCE credit or better in at least 2 subjects in not more than 2 sittings with a minimum of 5 years working experience in a reputable organisation.

ii) **Technician Diploma in Accounting (TDA)**

iii) **Diploma in Business Administration and Management**

An applicant must have passed the West African Senior School Certificate Examinations (WASSCE) with credit or better in at least four (4) subjects in not more than two (2) sittings and, perform reasonably well in the interview will be considered.

Applicants must have a first Degree from a well-recognized University including Five (5) subjects at WASSCE or GCE O'Levels

D. DISTANCE LEARNING

ENTRY REQUIREMENT FOR TEACHERS CERTIFICATE (3 YEARS DURATION)

To be eligible, applicant should have:

- a) Two (2) G.C.E. 'O' level or WASSCE
- b) Completed Form 5 or SSS 3 and pass the University entrance Exam in Mathematics, English and General Studies
- c) Have at least two years of teaching experience and pass the University entrance examination in Mathematics and General Studies.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT FOR HIGHER TEACHERS CERTIFICATE (PRIMARY) (3 YEARS)

To be eligible, applicant must have:

- a) Three (3) WASSCE/GCE Credits including English Language in not more than two sittings
- b) Obtained a Teacher Certificate with at least two (2) years of teaching experience from an approved school with School Identification Number (SID).

ENTRY REQUIREMENT FOR HIGHER TEACHERS CERTIFICATE (SECONDARY)(3 YEARS)

- a) Applicant should have four (4) credit or better in relevant subject areas including English in not more than two sittings.
- b) Have Higher Teachers Certificate (Primary with at least three GCE O' Level or WASSCE including English Language in not more than two sittings.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (4 YEARS)

The Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) is a four-year, distance programme offering specialization in Early Childhood Development and Secondary School specializations in two teaching subjects.

To be eligible for this programme, applicant should have:

- a) Five (5) credits GCE O' Level/WASSCE/NVQ with unit 5 or better including English Language in not more than two sittings. In the case of WAEC only grades varying from 1-6 are recognized as GCE O Level credits passed and A1-C6 for WASSCE
- b) Obtained a Higher Teachers Certificate (Secondary with 4 GCE O' Level/WASSCE including English in not more than two sittings

- c) Obtained a Higher Teachers Certificate (Primary) with four GCE O' Level/WASSCE including English Language in not more than two sittings with three-year teaching experience.

POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION (1 YEAR, 6 MONTHS) (18 MONTHS)

Applicant should have a degree with division two or better from a recognized university with at least a year working experience.
